

USTINGRADER VEREIN

1913 - 1963

While we are gathering in a mood of gayety and joy to celebrate our Golden Jubilee, commemorating our existence as an organized group for fifty years, it is worthy to put on the retrospect and look back to the time when we were just individuals scattered around without contact with each other, everyone alone in a strange world, without anyone to rejoice with his in his success or to advise him in difficulty.

There were, however, a few individuals who could fail to see beyond the ones that were successfully established of our Landslite. There were also some who met with obstructions on their way, and were not able to remove them alone without a helping hand.

It was not long after our Verein was organized that fate came to prove its necessity.

When our home town in the old country was stricken by war, revolution and futhless banditism, it was our Verein that united all the Ustingrader in the U. S. A. for effective relief work abroad — whether from indebtedness to individuals or group to group.

Its aims and purposes were and have remained that of mutual assistance locally, and to help relatives overseas emigrate to America.

The Verein, all during its existence has, within its means, extended a helping hand to local and national charitable institutions.

Its members became loyal American citizens. They educated their children in the public schools, universities and the colleges, established them in the trades, businesses and professions. Their children served our country with honor, in both World Wars and in Korea.

We say to ourselves at this gathering, "The present time is putting on us greater tasks than those of the past, greater problems and responsibilities are on us as a part of our community and nationality and on this occasion we pledge to stand by."
