Upon motion duly made seconded, and carried, the following were elected Trustees, to wit, Louis Cohen, Sam Krietor, Charles Dozoretz, Lieber Obstein, Peter Lazar, William Z. Snitzer, Henry Simon, Max Winer, Max Sommerstein and Max J. Sunshine.

The first three of the aforementioned persons, were elected until the first annual election of Trustees on October 1, 1941; the next three persons shall hold office until the second annual election of Trustees, and the following four persons shall hold office until the third annual election of Trustees.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, the same was adjourned.
